Parental Choice Online Application Information

Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP):

Enrollment Periods at Tamarack Waldorf School: Each month March - December from the 1st-20th

For 2017-18 School Year: MPCP applications must be submitted **online, between 1st-20th of each month,** at the above DPI website (Sept. deadline is 14th). Parent's valid email address is required to complete the application. Tamarack will not appear in the school list until March 1st.

- We recommend that MPCP applications be submitted online by the 15th of each month, to allow processing and review of applications prior to the deadline. This will also give allowable time for submission and review of supporting documentation needed to verify the application.
- We strongly recommend **using the DPI method of income verification**, not the DOR method when completing the MPCP application online.
- Parents must bring a copy of the MPCP application confirmation page (which can be printed once you submit the choice application online), along with required residency and income documentation to Tamarack by the enrollment deadline. A copy of the confirmation email from DPI is also acceptable, if you were unable to print the confirmation page after submitting the application.
- Parents must also bring a completed Tamarack school application, with recent report card for K5 and older.
- MPCP applications along with proof of residency are required every year for both new and continuing Choice students. If a student was waitlisted for all of 2016-17, or attended another Choice school, then the student is considered a "continuing" Choice student.
- Income verification is required for all "New" Choice student applications, and ALL high school applications. Income information is required at the high school level for tuition determination per DPI guidelines (some families may need to pay some tuition).
- Late applications and supporting documentation cannot be accepted under any circumstance per the DPI guidelines. If supporting documentation is not submitted, or submitted after the deadline, the MPCP application will not be accepted.
- Please make the necessary copies of forms and supporting documentation (residency, income, school application) required for your student's application to submit to the office.
- Bring the Choice Documentation and the school application to **Tamarack's main office, located at 1150 E Brady Street**. The office is open Monday – Friday 8:00am to 3:30pm.
