



# Tamarack Waldorf High School Admissions Process

---

The following steps must be complete before an admission to Tamarack is complete:

## STEP 1: FORMS

### A. Tamarack Waldorf High School Forms

Complete the forms in the High School Application Packet and student records, as listed below:

- Parent Questionnaire (High School Application)
- Student Questionnaire (High School Application)
- Authorization for Release of School Records Form
- Copy of most recent report card, attendance records and transcripts

### B. Recommendations

Ask three teachers at your present school to complete the TWHS recommendation form:

- English / Social Studies Teacher Recommendation
- Math / Science Teacher Recommendation
- World Language Teacher Recommendation

## STEP 2: VISIT

Parents attend an Information Evening, Open House or tour of Tamarack Waldorf High School. Students should also spend a day shadowing at the high school.

## STEP 3: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Parents should speak with the Enrollment Director about financial arrangements for their student, be it entering into a private payment arrangement/contract, applying for tuition assistance, or filling out the online paperwork (and then verifying last steps at Tamarack) for the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program.

## STEP 4: INTERVIEW

After a first visit to the school, and receipt of application materials, records and recommendations, a sit-down conversation will be scheduled, which will include the student and the parents/guardians.

One aspect of this conversation may be an assessment test, to gauge where each student aligns with other students in his or her class, as well as with the High School's expectations for each grade. Another aspect of the interview is the student presenting his or her "best work" to TWHS faculty.

## STEP 5: ENROLLMENT/ACCEPTANCE

The High School Enrollment Specialist will contact the family to discuss acceptance and next steps.

## STEP 6: LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING AGREEMENT

Once the family has signed and returned the Student Letter of Understanding, the student is officially enrolled in our school. Information will be sent to the family about registration and orientation – and parent evenings to start the new year.
