

Tamarack Waldorf High School Admissions Process



The following steps – forms, records, recommendations and visit to the school – can take place in any order, but all must be complete before an admissions interview can be scheduled.

STEP 1: FORMS

A. Tamarack Waldorf High School Forms:

Complete the following four forms in the High School Application Packet and include a copy of your student's most recent report card:

- High School Application Form
- Parent Questionnaire
- Student Questionnaire
- Authorization for Release of School Records Form
- Copy of most recent report card

B. Recommendations:

Ask two teachers or counselors at your present school to complete the TWHS recommendation form - one from an English/Humanities teacher and one from a Math/Science teacher.

- Teacher/Counselor Recommendation Form
- Teacher/Counselor Recommendation Form

STEP 2: VISIT

Families may attend an Information Evening, Open House or tour of Tamarack Waldorf High School. Students should also spend a day shadowing at the high school.

STEP 3: INTERVIEW

After a first visit to the school, and **upon receipt of all application materials** – parent and student forms, recommendations, test scores, grades and/or transcripts – a sit-down conversation will be scheduled to include parent(s) and the student, to get to know you better.

One aspect of this conversation may be an assessment test, to gauge where each student aligns with other students in his or her class, as well as with the High School's expectations for each grade.

STEP 4: ENROLLMENT/ACCEPTANCE

The High School Enrollment Specialist will contact the family to discuss acceptance and next steps.

STEP 5: LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING AGREEMENT

Once the family has signed and returned the Student Letter of Understanding, the student is officially enrolled in our school.
